Re: Application by DHJB Development, LLC for a major amendment to TPDES Permit No. WQ0014975001; TCEQ Docket No. 2013-2228-MWD; SOAH Docket No. 582-14-3427.

This letter is in response to Applicant DHJB Development, LLC and the Johnson Ranch MUD's (Movants) May 14, 2015 Combined Motion for Extension of Time to File Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision (Motion) regarding the above-referenced matter. The deadline for filing exceptions in this matter was March 30, 2015 at 5:00 pm. The Combined Exceptions of DHJB Development, LLC and the Johnson Ranch MUD (the filing at issue), was received by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's Office of the Chief Clerk at 5:35 p.m. on March 30, 2015, after the 5:00 filing deadline. The Movants assert that a good faith effort to timely-file the exceptions in this matter was made, but the filing was delayed slightly due to technical difficulties. Movants further state that there is no prejudice or harm to the other parties in granting the requested extension.

On May 18, 2015 Charles Irvine filed a letter on behalf of Protestants Patricia Graham, Terrell Graham, Margie Hastings, Asa Dunn, and the Greater Edwards Aquifer Alliance, responding to the Motion. Protestants urge in their letter that the Motion be denied due to a lack of jurisdiction and substantive and procedural deficiencies as identified in their letter.

Pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code §§1.10(h) and 80.257(b) and the Commission's Resolution in Docket No. 2009-0059-RES, this letter hereby extends the time for filing exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's proposal for decision until **5:36 p.m. on Monday, March 30, 2015**. This letter does not authorize the filing of any additional documents in this matter.
