As a small business owner, we built and opened the mobile home park in 1968. We drilled the water well to provide water to the park and have served our customers without any issues/incidents for the past 46 years. We are being asked to operate our mobile home park like a municipal water district for our small business. We feel like this is not feasible and puts an undo expense on our Small Business. We are not able to comply with the necessary steps that are being asked of us. We do not have the manpower or the financial means to comply with the same standards as a Municipal Water Supply, like the City of Texarkana.

We feel like the laws and regulations that were in place when we built and opened the park in 1968 should still apply. We have had no complaints or issues with our water supply and have had the water tested multiple times throughout the years by the Texarkana Water Utilities Laboratory. We continue to take samples from the well and have the lab test them on a monthly basis.
