

How to Obtain a URL with Geographic Coordinates for use in Notifications

1. Open the internal query for Central Registry (<http://prs.tceq.texas.gov/crintrpt/index.cfm>).
2. Enter the Additional ID and click submit.

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4. The resulting table will contain the latitude and longitude. To create a URL that will later zoom the user to that location on the map, simply click the [Copy Map It URL](#) button. This will create a URL containing the latitude and longitude and copy it to your clipboard. This can then be pasted (using Cntrl V) into your notification document or e-mail.



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5. To view the site on the map, click the [Map It](#) button. The flag  indicates the location of the facility/site.
6. Once in the map viewer, there are a number of tools available to the user:
- Basemaps** – enables user to select between one of three backgrounds



b. Navigation Tools:

- Use pan tool  to click 'n drag the map around.
- Alternatively, you can use the nav tool  to go north, south, east, or west.
- To zoom in and out, either use the  or  tools or use the wheel on the mouse.

c. **Search Tools:** - Click the Find tab and can search by multiple criteria:






7. To obtain new lat/long coordinates, follow these brief steps:

- a. Select the **Collect** tab and click on the Collect Data button. A message will appear telling you to click on a location.



- b. A green flag  will appear in the location clicked.
- c. Single click on the flag and a pop-up box will appear containing the coordinates. Additional information such as the zoom level and map type (h=satellitemap,r=roadmap,t=terrainmap) also appear.



- d. To save this information to a local document, swipe over the text and hit Cntrl C to copy, then paste (or Cntrl V) into your local document for future reference. (A future version may include the ability to create a function to capture this URL directly from the viewer).

Note: At this time, if you make any changes to the mapping coordinates, you will need to either enter the new Lat/Long into Central Registry or submit the new coordinates to Central Registry (REGISTRY@tceq.texas.gov). Once updated in Central Registry, you can repeat the first part of this procedure, again using the [Copy Map It URL](#) button to create the new URL for inclusion in your notice.
