


2008 Eight-Hour Ozone Standard for the HGB Area

- EPA Final Classifications
 - Published in the May 21, 2012, *Federal Register* (77 FR 30160) effective July 20, 2012
 - Marginal classification
 - December 31, 2015 attainment date
- Implementation Rule for 2008 Eight-Hour Ozone Standard
 - Not finalized by the EPA until April 2013
- No SIP project currently being developed
 - Emissions inventory and emissions statement due July 20, 2014
 - No other SIP requirements for marginal classification



Projected SIP Development Timeline for Marginal Classification





Possible Involuntary Failure to Attain/Reclassification

- The EPA will determine attainment of 2008 ozone standard with 2013 through 2015 monitor data.
- If the EPA determines the HGB area failed to attain the 2008 ozone standard, it may publish a finding of failure to attain and reclassify the area.
