Re: Update for Southeast Texas Survey of Compressor Engines and Dehydrators

Dear Owner/Operator:

In the letter dated September 19, 2008, you were informed that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) was developing an improved area source emissions inventory for stationary gas-fired compressor engines and dehydrators. The owners and/or operators of these types of sources were requested to provide air emissions-related information for calendar year 2007.

Due to the recent damage created by Hurricane Ike, the TCEQ recognizes that your normal business operations may have been impacted and is extending the due date until November 21, 2008, to provide the requested air emissions-related information for compressor engines rated at 50 horsepower or greater and dehydrators.
