Opening Remarks

Frances Dowiak, Air Quality Planning Section, gave opening remarks.

Presentation

Frances Dowiak presented information concerning the background and scope of the current rule project to address eight CTG documents published by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) from 2006 through 2008. The presentation can be found on the [CTG Stakeholder Group Web page](#).

Summary of Open Discussion

Question: A stakeholder asked why the timeline for this rule project is different than the timeline for the 2013 Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW) State Implementation Plan (SIP).

Response: This rule project and the DFW SIP timelines are on the same schedule.

Question: A stakeholder asked if the existing 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 115 rules define the term *manufacturer* and asked what the term *manufacturer* is intended to mean with respect to the applicability of the Miscellaneous Industrial Adhesives CTG.

Response: The existing Chapter 115 rules do not include a general definition of the term *manufacturer* that would be relevant to industrial adhesive use. The EPA's Miscellaneous Industrial Adhesives CTG recommendations are intended to apply to manufacturers that use adhesives in the specified application processes. In the absence of a specific definition, the terms used in Chapter 115 have the meaning commonly used in the field of air pollution control.
