

The following documents are required to be published in the *Register*: applications to purchase control of state banks filed by the Banking Commissioner of Texas pursuant to Texas Civil Statutes, Article 342-401a(B)(6); changes in interest rate filed by the Savings and Loan Commissioner of Texas pursuant to Texas Civil Statutes, Article 5069-1.07; and consultant proposal requests and awards filed by state agencies, regional councils of government, and the Texas State Library pursuant to Texas Civil Statutes, Article 6252-11c. In order to allow agencies to communicate information quickly and effectively, other information of general interest to the public of Texas is published as space allows.

Correction of Error

Several proposals submitted by the Texas Air Control Board contained errors as published in the August 4 and 7 issues of the *Texas Register*. The corrections are as follows:

In the August 4 issue:

At 6 TexReg 2824—Under the editor's note listing the undesignated headings of Chapter 115, starting with "Storage of Volatile Organic Compounds in Bexar, Brazoria, Dallas, El Paso, Galveston, Gregg, Harris, Jefferson, Nueces, Orange, Tarrant, and Victoria Counties," Bexar County should have been deleted. The TACB is proposing to delete Bexar County from Regulation V sections relating to ozone nonattainment counties and to add it to Regulation V sections relating to "counties in other than ozone nonattainment areas."

At 6 TexReg 2827—The text of §111.92 (131.03.08.002) should have read:

Except as noted in **§111.76 of this title (relating to Compliance) and paragraphs (1) and (2) of this section**, all persons shall be in compliance with all provisions of Regulation I no later than **December 31, 1973** [the effective date of this section].

(1)-(2) (No change.)

In the August 7 issue:

At 6 TexReg 2871—Under the editor's note listing the undesignated headings in Chapter 115, the heading "Vent Gas Control in Brazoria, Dallas, El Paso, Galveston, Gregg, Harris, Jefferson, Nueces, Orange, Tarrant, and Victoria Counties" should not have contained Gregg County. Also in the editor's note, in "Fugitive Emission Control in Petroleum Refineries in Bexar, Brazoria, Dallas, El Paso, Galveston, Gregg, Harris, Jefferson, Nueces, Orange, Tarrant, and Victoria Counties," Bexar County should have been deleted.

At 6 TexReg 2872 and 6 TexReg 2886—The undesignated heading "Compliance in Brazoria, Dallas, El Paso, Galveston, Gregg, Harris, Jefferson, Nueces, Orange, Tarrant, and Victoria Counties" should have read: "Compliance and Control Plan Requirements in Brazoria, Dallas, El Paso, Galveston, Gregg, Harris, Jefferson, Nueces, Orange, Tarrant, and Victoria Counties."

At 6 TexReg 2875—The text of §115.104 should have read:

The owner or operator of any storage vessel with an external floating roof **which is exempted from the requirement for a secondary seal and used to store...**
