



SIP Revision: BPA Attainment Area On-Road Mobile Source Emissions Inventory and MVEB Update, November 14, 2012

On November 14, 2012, the commission adopted a revision to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) updating the on-road mobile source emissions inventories and motor vehicle emissions budgets (MVEB) included in the Beaumont-Port Arthur (BPA) Redesignation Request and Maintenance Plan SIP Revision that was adopted on December 10, 2008.

Summary of the SIP Revision

This SIP revision replaced the on-road mobile source emissions inventories that were adopted in 2008 as part of the [BPA Redesignation Request and Maintenance Plan SIP Revision](#) for the 1997 Eight-Hour Ozone Standard. The previously adopted on-road mobile source emissions inventories were based on the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) MOBILE model, and those adopted with this update are based on the EPA's Motor Vehicle Emission Simulator (MOVES) model. On-road mobile source emissions inventory updates include those for 2005, 2011, 2014, 2017, and 2021. In addition, 2021 nitrogen oxides and volatile organic compounds MVEBs are updated to reflect use of the MOVES model for determining on-road mobile source emissions inventories.
