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IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

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REVISION INFORMATION

The Texas Implementation Plan, dated January 28, 1972, revised February 15, April 15, and August 15, 1973 is being updated and reprinted with the publishing of this February 15, 1974 issue. The changes consist primarily of updating information and data to correspond to the present time frame. Following is a description of the changes made in some sections of the Plan.

SECTION I - INTRODUCTION

- a. Service Organizations - Revised to reflect present organizational structure.
- b. Regional Descriptions - Status and time references changed to reflect the appropriate situation.

SECTION II - REGIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS

National Secondary Standard for Sulfur Dioxide revised.

SECTION V - LEGAL AUTHORITY

In the Texas Clean Air Act, the amendment by Chapter 469, Acts of the 63rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1973, has been included.

SECTION VII - COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE

Texas Air Control Board Enforcement Orders have been added to the Table on Compliance Abatement Schedules to indicate the latest status.

SECTION VIII - EPISODE PLAN

This Section has been completely rewritten. The new section outlines the procedures that have evolved from the original plan.

SECTION IX - AIR QUALITY SURVEILLANCE PLAN

A statement of progress has been added. Pages of the air quality surveillance system schedule have been revised to reflect the latest status.

SECTION X - THE PERMIT SYSTEM

The latest Permit System Procedures are included.

SECTION XI - SOURCE SURVEILLANCE

Data no longer applicable has been deleted.

SECTION XIII - INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION

Information on funding of local programs has been added.

SECTION XIV - RULES AND REGULATIONS

Current Rules and Regulations are included.

APPENDIX B - AIR QUALITY DATA SUMMARY

The inclusion of air quality data in the Implementation Plan will not be continued for future revisions. The full range of air quality data is too extensive to be printed in an implementation plan. Data is maintained by computer and submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency on a quarterly basis.

REVISION INFORMATION

August 15, 1974

The Texas Air Pollution Control Implementation Plan, revised and reprinted on February 15, 1974, is being revised as follows:

All of section revised to correct Regional Office information, outline changed procedures and include the new Source Surveillance Investigator's Report.

Summary of 1972 Emission Inventory

REVISION INFORMATION

February 15, 1975

Following is a description of a revision to the February 15, 1974 reprint of the Texas Implementation Plan. The pages dated February 15, 1975 were submitted as part of the SIP Semiannual Report. The pages dated April 15, 1975 were revised subsequent to the report.

SECTION I - INTRODUCTION

Reference information for wind rose data has been added.

SECTION II - REGIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS

Priority classifications have been updated using 1973 ambient air quality data and 1972 emission data. Public hearings were held in January 1975. The priority classification revisions were approved at the January 1975 meeting of the Texas Air Control Board and submitted to EPA by the Governor of Texas on March 21, 1975.

SECTION VI - CONTROL STRATEGY

The control strategy for carbon monoxide (CO) has been revised to reflect the revision to priority classifications. In accordance with a revision to Regulation II, Control of Air Pollution for Sulfur Compounds, the control strategy for sulfur dioxide (SO₂) applicable to Region 11 - El Paso, was revised. The regulation and control strategy was submitted to EPA by the Governor on April 7, 1975.

SECTION VII - COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE

Compliance abatement schedules have been updated.

SECTION IX - AIR QUALITY SURVEILLANCE PLAN

The minimum federal monitoring requirements table has been revised to reflect the prescribed equipment in accordance with the updated regional priority classifications.

SECTION X - THE PERMIT SYSTEM

Construction and operating permit forms were revised.

SECTION XII - RESOURCES

This Section has been revised to present the estimation of resource requirements for the period of 1975 to 1980.

SECTION XIV - RULES AND REGULATIONS

The new Regulation II is included. Revised pages are annotated. Appendix A and B of the regulation have not been changed and should be retained.

APPENDIX A

Since emission inventory data is now being maintained in the National Emissions Data System (NEDS) format for computer data processing, the emission data for Appendix A of the implementation plan is being deleted.

SECTION XIV - RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Rules, pages 10 and 11; Regulation VI and Regulation VIII have been revised.

REVISION INFORMATION

February 15, 1976

The table on Applicable Laws has been revised to reflect the latest dates for regulations. A new paragraph has been added to describe new procedures as a result of the recently passed Texas Administrative Procedures Act.
