Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the requirements established by Section 3.09 of the Texas Clean Air Act, an examiner for the Texas Air Control Board will conduct a public hearing commencing at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 9, 1971, and continuing through Saturday, December 11, 1971, in the Capitol Ballroom of the Stephen F. Austin Hotel, 701 Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas, for the purpose of receiving public testimony concerning the proposed Implementation Plan, Air Quality Standards, Rules and Regulations I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII and VIII of the Texas Air Control Board.

Interested persons are invited to submit data, views and recommendations on the proposed Implementation Plan, Air Quality Standards, and Rules and Regulations either orally or in writing at the hearing. Parties desiring to present written testimony at the hearing are requested to submit fifteen (15) copies of their statements in writing to the Texas Air Control Board, 820 East 53rd Street, Austin, Texas, on or before November 28, 1971.

Due to limitations of time and facilities, the Texas Air Control Board requests that industry representatives testify on Thursday, December 9, 1971, through 12:00 noon on Friday, December 10, 1971. Testimony from citizens and citizen group representatives is requested from 1:00 p.m. on Friday, December 10, 1971, through Saturday, December 11, 1971. Any person unable to give testimony as requested herein shall be permitted to give testimony at any convenient time during the hearing. Further, the hearing will be open at all times to all persons whether or not they expect to give testimony.

The hearing will be continued from time to time and from place to place, if necessary, to develop all pertinent information bearing on the subject of the hearing.
