The following are changes/clarifications/additions to the above referenced Solicitation.

- Item A. Request for Grant Applications, Page 4, Section 1.0., paragraph 3, first bullet which states: “biodiesel (as defined by Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Title 34, Part 1, Chapter 3, Subchapter S §3.443 (b)(3)).” With regard to this criterion, the following clarification is provided.

To be eligible for AFFP funding, biodiesel and biodiesel blends must meet the following criteria: (1) biodiesel must meet the definition for biodiesel as specified in Title 34, Texas Administrative Code (34 TAC), §3.443; and (2) biodiesel blends, as defined in 34 TAC §3.443, must be comprised of at least 20% biodiesel by volume (B20), at a minimum. B20 biodiesel blends must meet the ASTM D7467 standards.

- Item B. Request for Grant Applications, Page 7, Section 1.5., paragraph 2, first bullet which states: “biodiesel (as defined by Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Title 34, Part 1, Chapter 3, Subchapter S §3.443 (b)(3)).” With regard to this criterion, the following clarification is provided.

To be eligible for AFFP funding, biodiesel and biodiesel blends must meet the following criteria: (1) biodiesel must meet the definition for biodiesel as specified in Title 34, Texas Administrative Code (34 TAC), §3.443; and (2) biodiesel blends, as defined in 34 TAC §3.443, must be comprised of at least 20% biodiesel by volume (B20), at a minimum. B20 biodiesel blends must meet the ASTM D7467 standards.

- Item C. Request for Grant Applications, Page 6, Section 1.4. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS AND AREAS, subsection “Eligible locations” paragraph 1, first bullet, change the following description:  
**From:** Dallas-Fort Worth(DFW) 8-Hour Ozone Nonattainment Area including Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Johnson, Kaufman, Parker, Rockwall, and Tarrant Counties;  
**To:** Dallas-Fort Worth(DFW) 8-Hour Ozone Nonattainment Area including Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Johnson, Kaufman, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant, and Wise Counties;
