- We have completed a second round of driver training for all three city fleets.

- We have provided FedEx with an updated engineering spec sheet in order for them to accept the test vehicles into their fleet.

- We made an upgrade trip to Texas to upgrade all vehicles that needed 12 volt battery protectors.
- We brought one of the City of Dallas trucks back to Colorado for a battery pack operating system upgrade.
