1. Purpose. This change transmittal provides the page(s) that reflect changes and additions to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (commission) Volume of Permanent Rules.
2. Explanation of Change. On July 8, 2009, the commission adopted an amendment to §21.3 *with changes* to the proposed text as published in the March 13, 2009, issue of the *Texas Register* (34 TexReg 1780) and was republished. Section 290.51 was adopted *without change* as published in the March 13, 2009, issue of the *Texas Register* (34 TexReg 1780) and was not republished.
3. Effect of Change. The adopted rulemaking would increase the Public Health Services fee, the Consolidated Water Quality fee, and the Water Use Assessment fee to ensure that there are sufficient funds to carry out the tasks required to protect water resources in the state.
