1. Purpose. This change transmittal provides the page(s) that reflect changes and additions to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (commission) Volume of Permanent Rules.
2. Explanation of Change. On April 13, 2005, the commission adopted amendments to §§293.1, 293.11, 293.41, 293.44, 293.51, 293.59, 293.80, 293.83, 293.113, 293.201, and 293.202. Sections 293.11, 293.41, 293.44, 293.51, 293.59, and 293.202 were adopted *with changes* to the proposed text as published in the October 29, 2004, issue of the *Texas Register* (29 TexReg 10073). Sections 293.1, 293.80, 293.83, 293.113, and 293.201 were adopted *without changes* to the proposed text and were not republished.

The commission also adopted amendments to §§301.1 - 301.4, 301.6, 301.21, 301.31, 301.38, 301.43, 301.45, 301.51, 301.71, 301.73, and 301.74; and the repeal of §§301.5, 301.22, and 301.23 *without changes* to the proposed text as published in the October 29, 2004, issue of the *Texas Register* (29 TexReg 10073), and the text was not republished.

3. Effects of Change. The rulemaking amends Chapter 293 by establishing new or revising existing requirements relating to the administration and supervision of water districts. Amendments to Chapter 301 delete references to “plans of reclamation,” delete the requirement to obtain commission approval of such plans, and add the requirement that an engineer’s report be prepared in lieu of a plan of reclamation.
