WATER QUALITY SEPS: WATER AND WASTE VIOLATIONS QUALIFY

| 1 | <p>Collection Events whereby Respondent will advertise to citizens that they may bring items for proper disposal at no cost:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tires; • Household Hazardous, including but not limited to BOPA (batteries, used oil, paint and anti-freeze); • Electronics; and/or • Large Solid Waste items (old mattresses, appliances without Freon, broken furniture, brush and limbs, etc.). |
| 2 | <p>Removal of dilapidated housing that contains asbestos and/or lead paint:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Property must be preserved for perpetuity for public use, such as a park; and • Extensive material testing for asbestos and/or lead paint will be required for this project. |
| 3 | <p>Cleanup of illegal dump sites, including tires:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligible sites will be those where a responsible party cannot be found; or • is unable to clean the site; and • where reasonable efforts have been made to prevent dumping. <p>A site owned by Respondent is not eligible unless Respondent is:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A governmental entity that acquired the site through escheat, foreclosure, eminent domain, or bequest after the dumping occurred; and 2. There is a clear benefit to the community, such as when the land is cleaned for preservation as a park. |
| 4 | <p>Erosion Control Project on a natural shoreline around a creek, river or lake:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vegetation removal for flood control does not qualify as a SEP; • Man-made drainage ditches do not qualify as a SEP; and • Photos and map of eroded area will be required with the SEP application. |
| 5 | <p>Extend first-time sewer service to low-income* residents who are utilizing failing septic systems:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wastewater violations (MWD) do not qualify for this SEP; and • *According to HUD standards. |
| 6 | <p>Extend first-time water service to low-income* residents who are utilizing shallow or contaminated well water:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public water supply violations (PWS) do not qualify for this SEP; and • *According to HUD standards. |
| 7 | <p>Dam repairs for dams on the agency's list of high-risk dams.</p> |

| 8 | <p>Swap-out gas-powered equipment for electric, such as lawn mowers.</p> |
