Project Description:

Restore the 600-acre upland habitat at the Mitchell Lake Audubon Center and Sanctuary by removing non-native, exotic plant species and re-establishing native grasses, forbs, and woody vegetation. Native plants that will provide maximum benefit for the wildlife of Mitchell Lake will be reintroduced throughout the uplands.
