Neighborhood Cleanup Events

Project Description:

The City of El Paso shall hold collection events to collect, properly dispose, or recycle household non-hazardous materials such as used tires, motor oil, batteries, antifreeze, and bulky solid waste. The City of El Paso shall offer a convenient drop off location at no cost to the public. The event will be advertised in a local newspaper to increase public awareness of and participation in the event. These cleanup events will be available to neighborhood associations or other groups upon request. Roll-off boxes, transportation and disposal services will be provided for the waste collected.

City of El Paso shall ensure that the collection event:

- occurs during daylight hours
- offers to the public convenient drop-off locations
- does not include collection of hazardous waste
- uses personnel and contractors with proper authorization(s), who are knowledgeable about appropriate methods for the collection, storage, and disposal of potentially hazardous waste
- is advertised in at least one newspaper of large circulation in the geographic area, or if limited to neighborhood associations, is advertised appropriately to ensure participation in the event

The City of El Paso shall perform this project including collection, transport, storage, disposal of, or recycling of the collected materials in accordance with practices recommended by TCEQ and in accordance with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. SEP funds will be used for equipment and hourly labor costs of employees where appropriate, public announcement of the event, costs of contractor(s) with proper authorization(s), and disposal and recycling costs. The City of El Paso shall use SEP Offset Amount only for the direct cost of implementing the project and no portion shall be spent on City of El Paso's administrative costs.

The City of El Paso certifies that there is no prior commitment to do this project and that it is being performed solely as a supplemental environmental project.

Environmental Benefit:

This SEP will provide a discernible environmental benefit by providing for the proper disposal of debris and waste that can release chemicals into the soil, water, and air, which will help rid the community of the dangers and health threats associated with non-regulated dumping. The SEP will also provide for recycling of materials, which will help conserve landfill capacity.
