THIRD PARTY AGREEMENT

**Project Description: Texas Point Marsh Beneficial Use of Dredged Material Project**

**Description:** The project will use dredge spoil material to restore eight miles of shoreline within the Texas Point National Wildlife Refuge in Jefferson County, Sabine Pass, Texas. SEP monies will be used for the installation of an estimated 2,000,000 cubic yards of dredge spoil material along Sabine-Neches Waterway, as well as building up the jetties along the entrance to the Sabine Pass region and adding additional granite and dredge materials, which include rocks that will increase the base width and total height. Jefferson County Waterway and Navigation District will do sampling of the dredge spoilage beforehand to determine if human or environmental receptors will be adversely affected.

**Benefit:** The project will provide a discernible environmental benefit by reducing and preventing the loss of land and natural habitat due to shoreline erosion, re-establishing a natural dune ridge system, and by minimizing storm damage to Texas Point National Wildlife Refuge habitats, and the re-establishment of a functional marsh ecosystem.

**Eligible Counties:** Jefferson County.
