THIRD PARTY AGREEMENT

Cameron County

Project Title: Exotic Species Control, Sabal Palm Sanctuary

Description: Manually remove non-native plants in the sanctuary. Guinea grass, Brazilian pepper, Nephitis and Popinac are extremely invasive exotic plants which are threatening to smother nearly 10 acres of a native plant restoration project that is being implemented.

Estimate Cost: \$6,000 per year

Benefits: Exotic plant species will be removed continuously over two years thus allowing native species to be restored on the sanctuary.
