

Specialized Composting Training

Supervisors of composting facilities who obtained a Class “A” or “B” license by completing only the MSW “A” or “B” course will be required to complete the applicable specialized training to be eligible to renew the license.

- If your license expires before June 27, 2012, you will have until June 27, 2012 to complete the specialized training.
- If your license expires after June 27, 2012, you will need to complete the training before your license expiration date.

The following training providers provide composting training meeting the requirements for the specialized training for the supervisors of registered or permitted composting sites. As more information is available on additional training, it will be posted on the TCEQ website.
