2011 Job Task Analysis Survey Groundwater Treatment and Distribution

To update a job analysis of your profession, the Texas Commission on Environment Quality (TCEQ) is requesting the participation of all **licensed operators performing ground water treatment or operating distribution systems, including operators performing treatment of groundwater under the influence of surface water**. A critical part of the job analysis is an online survey of operators. The TCEQ plans to use job analysis results to assess if changes are needed to the operator licensing program including licensing requirements, examinations, and training.

Important survey information:

1. Survey is available online throughout **April beginning April 1, 2011**.
2. Operators can access the survey at the following site:

3. To login to the survey you need a **unique key**.
4. The **unique key** or password is your **nine character license number** (e.x. WD0001234).
Note: If you have a class D or A water operator license, be sure to use WO (alpha characters) with 7 numbers following the two alpha characters.
5. **Operators can earn 2 hours of training credit** toward renewal of their license(s) by successfully completing the survey.

Texas State University (TSU) at San Marcos is the TCEQ contractor responsible for collecting and analyzing the job survey responses.
