

# Introducing e-App for Licensing



e-App for Licensing is the online version of the application you must submit and have approved by the TCEQ prior to registering for the corresponding exam. e-App captures the same information as the current paper application.

## ***How to obtain an occupational license:***

1. Make sure you meet all the licensing requirements and have all the supporting documentation. Visit [www.tceq.texas.gov/licensing](http://www.tceq.texas.gov/licensing).
2. Complete and submit an online application using e-App for Licensing. You'll pay the application fee during the online process. (Most licenses cost \$111.)
3. Wait. In 6 to 8 weeks, you'll receive an approval letter in the mail or a deficiency letter asking you to clear a few things up.
4. Once you receive an approval letter, you can register to take your exam!
5. Pass the exam! We'll give you up to 4 attempts or one year, whichever comes first, so don't worry if you don't pass the exam the first time.
6. Your license will be issued within a few days upon passing the exam.
