On January 28, 2010, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) objected to the proposed Title V permit for the Ineos USA, LLC (Ineos) Green Lake Complex facility. On June 30, 2010, we received the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Executive Director's Response to EPA's Objection (RTO), proposed permit, and associated Statement of Basis. Ineos then submitted additional background information to the TCEQ regarding Ineos' use of the qualified facility exemption, and an emission limitation table for inclusion in the permit. TCEQ revised the permit to incorporate the emission limit table. We received the revised permit and supporting information via e-mail on April 11, 2012. We have reviewed the documents, and have no further comments. Please note that EPA may review the issued permit if it receives a public petition pursuant to 40 CFR § 70.8(d).

We are committed to working with the TCEQ to ensure that permits address all applicable requirements, including the Texas SIP, and are consistent with the federally-approved Texas Title V air permitting program.
