On October 30, 2009, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) objected to the proposed Title V permit for the Formosa Plastics LLDPE, HDPE I, and HDPE II facility. On June 30, 2010, we received the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Executive Director's Response to Public Comment and EPA's Objection (RTO), proposed permit, and associated Statement of Basis. In addition, we received supplemental information on December 19, 2012, from your office. We have reviewed the documents, and have no further comments.
