Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921168

Application. Double D Feedyard, LLC, 660 County Road 620, Dimmitt, Texas 79027 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant has removed two Land Management Units (LMUs) LMU DD 1 - 500 acres and LMU DD 4 - 500 acres from the list of authorized LMUs and decreased the acreage of LMU DD 3 from 292 acres to 253 acres. The total LMU acreage has decreased from 1,408 acres to 369 acres. The facility maps have been revised to show the new property boundary. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on February 8, 2016.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 660 County Road 620, Dimmitt, Castro County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the White River Lake in Segment No. 1240 of the Brazos River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
