Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921355

Application. Hartley Farms, LLC, 5537 Farm-to-Market Road 281, Dumas, Texas 79029 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is decreasing the acreage of land management unit (LMU) #10 – from 308 acres to 234. The total land application acreage has decreased from 4,928 acres to 4,854 acres. Other changes include the update to the LMU map, revised runoff control map to show the post-construction layout of the dairy facility, and the addition of retention control structure R2. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on April 5, 2016.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located approximately 1.75 miles East of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 807 and Farm-to-Market Road 2577 on the South side of Farm-to-Market Road 807 in Hartley County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the unclassified Segment No. 0100 of the Canadian River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
