Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921388

Application. Feedyards, Inc., P.O. Box 3050, Amarillo, Texas 79116 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant has removed land management unit (LMU) WCF-1 – 84 acres from the list of authorized LMUs. The total land application area has decreased from 576 to 492 acres. Another proposed change is the addition of four new retention control structures (RCSs): WCF- West Evap-1, WCF- West Evap-2, WCF- West Evap-3, and WCF- West Evap-4; and the removal of former RCS WCF-West-Evap. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on October 18, 2016.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 13352 Farm-to-Market Road 2711, Perryton, Ochiltree County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Wolf Creek in Segment No. 0104 of the Canadian River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
