Please also be advised that pursuant to the Texas Water Code §26.3475 the TNRCC is now authorized to order the shutdown of any underground storage tank (UST) system which is found to be noncompliant with release detection, and spill and/or overfill prevention regulations, until such time as the UST system is brought into compliance with Commission regulations.
