

**1. Comment From: City of Marble Falls**

David Galindo and WQ Staff,

Thank you very much for holding the stakeholder meeting last week. The City of Marble Falls views favorably the petition, and supports the rule amendment. Such amendment will encourage water conservation by expanding the reuse system.

We would like to see only one minor change to the amendment. We are of the opinion that the 80% firm reuse number for land equivalence should be changed to 100%. The cities will already prove that the firm water usage for irrigation is the lowest usage recorded. There should be no reason to reduce that any further. This is in regard to the 30 TAC 221.121.d.10 section of the petition. It notes that it does not account for 20% of the reclaimed water if used for irrigation. We are against this wording; it appears to be an arbitrary number. We are of the opinion that such wording should be removed.

Other than the above comment, we are looking forward to the rule change.
