





Jones Road

NOTICE

Re: **Groundwater Contamination and Restricted Water Well Drilling Area in Northwest Houston, Harris County, Texas.**

The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) has been informed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) of groundwater contamination in Northwest Houston, Harris County, Texas, north of FM 1960 along Jones Road. The TCEQ conducted water well sampling and analysis in the affected area (as indicated on the attached map) which detected concentrations of Tetrachloroethene (PCE), Trichloroethene (TCE), and cis-1,2-Dichloroethene (DCE).

The attached map (with street names) outlines the contamination monitoring and restricted drilling area. The known groundwater contamination plume is located in Grid 65-04-4 of the Texas Water Well Numbering System within this delineated area. Due to contamination in the known area, landowners or persons having wells drilled should be informed of the possibility of groundwater contamination. Abandonment and plugging of water wells may also be required in this area for groundwater protection.

More stringent construction specifications will be required on any new water wells drilled within the restricted area. Any new water wells located within the specified area, at minimum must be drilled to the Evangeline aquifer with a 3-inch larger borehole than the outside diameter of the casing and pressure cemented from a depth of not less than approximately 400 feet back to the land surface. **Prior to drilling any new water wells within the outlined restricted drilling area, contact the TDLR's Water Well Driller/Pump Installer Section at 512/463-7880.**
