<b>Water body description:</b>	From Amistad Dam in Val Verde County to a point 1.8 km (1.1 miles) downstream of the confluence of Ramsey Canyon on the Rio Grande Arm in Val Verde County and to a point 0.7 km (0.4 miles) downstream of the confluence of Painted Canyon on the Pecos River Arm in Val Verde County and to a point 0.6 km (0.4 miles) downstream of the confluence of Little Satan Creek on the Devils River Arm in Val Verde County, up to the normal pool elevation of 1117 feet (impounds Rio Grande)

<b>Water body type:</b>	Reservoir
