Job Description:

Oversees Petroleum Storage Tank/Dry Cleaner Remediation Program (PST/DCRP) Section sites for all phases of geoscience work including site investigations, monitoring, and remediation for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Plans and coordinates all phases of highly advanced geoscience work in accordance with PST/DCRP Section guidelines; prioritizes sites for further work; performs technical evaluations of sites; and develops scopes of work for site investigations and corrective actions. Oversees contracts/work orders to achieve corrective action at PST/DCRP Section sites. Reviews invoices under prevailing agency guidelines and required time frames. Updates databases and maintains project files. Communicates with internal staff, the public, contractors, and other governmental entities. Represents the agency at technical functions, seminars, and meetings. Completes required core training. Attends technical and professional development training.

Minimum Qualifications:

Licensed as a Geoscientist by the Texas Board of Professional Geoscientists (TBPG) plus ten years of full-time geological experience. A graduate degree in a geoscience discipline (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION) may substitute for one year of the required experience, with a maximum of two years substitution allowed.

Preferred Requirements:

Experience in conducting and reviewing environmental investigations of Petroleum Storage Tank (PST) and Dry Cleaner Remediation Program (DCRP) sites.
Experience in conducting and reviewing environmental cleanups of Petroleum Storage Tank (PST) and Dry Cleaner Remediation Program (DCRP) sites.
Experience working with regulations at remediation cleanup sites/projects.
Experience in writing work orders and processing invoices for remedial investigations and cleanups of PST and DCRP sites.

Special Requirements:
