Job Description:

Performs advanced technical work and manages soil and groundwater corrective action projects requiring interpretation of geoscientific information independently for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Manages and coordinates remediation projects, which includes drafting documents to address technical reviews and queries; tracks correspondence to ensure completion in a timely manner. Processes site-specific special projects associated with remediation that are outside the standard work flow. Maintains files and database(s). Keeps management updated on facility progress. Provides customer service and answers questions from both internal and external customers. Participates in training and professional development. Provides leadership, geoscience expertise, management support, expert guidance, to the team/section/division and agency staff.

Minimum Qualifications:

Licensed as a Geoscientist by the Texas Board of Professional Geoscientists (TBPG) plus nine years of full-time geoscientific experience. A graduate degree in a geoscience discipline may substitute for one year of the required experience (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION), with a maximum of two years substitution allowed.

OR Two years of full-time TCEQ experience as a Geoscientist III.

Preferred Requirements:

Experience with the assessment and remediation of sites under Texas Risk Reduction Program (TRRP)/30 TAC 350.
Experience with applying geologic techniques, procedures, and theories; and reviewing and approving investigations of facilities.
Experience overseeing or conducting soil and groundwater investigations (i.e., affected property assessments or remedial investigations).

Special Requirements:

Moving up to 20 pounds of reports/office supplies and equipment.
Personal Protection Equipment, boots and gloves.
Traveling up to 15% of the time.

Condition of Employment:

TCEQ will verify Selective Service registration for males born on or after January 1, 1960. If exempt from Selective Service registration selected candidate must provide proof of exemption on first day of employment. Offers of employment are contingent on the candidate having legal authorization to work for the TCEQ. TCEQ will conduct a criminal history records search on candidates selected for posted vacancies.
