### **Job Description:**

Performs moderately complex technical work in the field of Waste Water/Drinking Water for the Houston Regional Office of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Conducts technical inspections, sanitary surveys, and follow-up investigations; prepares reports which documents field activities and observed conditions. Prepares technical papers regarding complaint investigations. Provides limited technical assistance to the public, regulated community, and other interested groups regarding the application of appropriate regulations. Collects environmental/water samples for analysis and reviews data results.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION), with a major in a natural or physical science, engineering, environmental studies, or related field.

One year of full-time experience in the field of environmental activities directly related to the examples of work performed may be substituted for each year (30 semester hours) of the required education.

### **Preferred Requirements:**

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in natural or physical science, engineering, environmental studies or related field.

Experience preparing technical papers (such as investigation reports and/or research papers).

### **Special Requirements:**

Moving up to 35 pounds of equipment/samples.

Traveling up to 50% of the time.

Using sampling equipment to conduct inspections.

Climbing to heights of 40 feet without acrophobia.

Working more than 40 hours per week, as needed, to complete assignments, or to assist with emergency response efforts.

### **Condition of Employment:**
