Job Description:

Completes complex technical work involving the analysis, development, programming, and implementation/modification of agency software applications for the Information Resources Division of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Performs coding for application maintenance, support, and development, based on requirements and design documentation and adhering to agency information technology (IT) standards. Designs and implements Java web applications. Performs design tasks for application maintenance, support, and development, based on requirements documentation and adhering to agency IT standards. Perform testing tasks for application maintenance, support, and development, against requirements and design documentation and adhering to agency IT standards; and involving unit, integration, or system testing. Assists customers with customer acceptance testing. Performs business analysis tasks for application maintenance, support, and development, which include creating requirements documentation, facilitating joint application development (JAD) sessions, analyzing requirements, achieving consensus among business areas, and enterprise analysis. Performs project management tasks for application maintenance, support, and development, which include creating charters, business cases, project plans, and status reports; leading sponsor meetings; and monitoring contractors. Performs Quality Assurance/Quality Control tasks for application maintenance, support and development, and participates/leads peer reviews as assigned. Provides customer support for agency applications and general IT areas.

Minimum Qualifications:

Four years of full-time experience in computer programming, computer system administration, and/or systems analysis.

OR A master's degree from an accredited college or university (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION), or technical college with a major in computer science, plus one year of full-time experience in computer programming, computer system administration, and/or systems analysis.

OR A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with 12 semester hours in computer science (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION), plus two years of full-time experience in computer programming, computer system administration, and/or systems analysis.

OR Completion of 30 semester hours (600 clock hours) in computer science from a licensed vocational, technical or

business school or accredited college(COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION) , plus two years of full-time experience in computer programming, computer system administration, and/or systems analysis.

OR Completion of 15 semester hours (300 clock hours) in computer science from a licensed vocational, technical or business school or accredited college (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION), plus three years of full-time experience in computer programming, computer system administration, and/or systems analysis.

Preferred Requirements:

Experience programming with JAVA, J2EE, JBOSS, Spring or SEAM, EJB, JSF, RichFaces, Hibernate, Oracle, PL/SQL, Java Script, XML, HTML.

Experience writing web services in JAVA and/or experience consuming/using web services.

Experience with configuration management, quality assurance, and/or change management.

Special Requirements:

Moving up to 20 pounds of boxes, files, papers, and training supplies.

Traveling up to 5% of the time.

Condition of Employment:
