Job Description:

Provides compliance assistance to small businesses, trade associations, local governments (including school districts), and agency staff for the Environmental Assistance Division (EAD) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Provides multi-media compliance assistance to small businesses and small local governments. Participates on special project teams related to small businesses and small local governments, including researching, developing, and preparing industry or media-specific materials on compliance and pollution prevention. Assists in planning, developing, preparations for, and conducting workshops and presentations on environmental compliance requirements. Develops internal and external partnerships, facilitating movement/completion of projects that are mutually beneficial to customers, partners, and the program. Reviews procedures, rules, regulations, or program guidelines as they impact small businesses and small local governments; and assists with the preparation of recommendations and justifications for changes. Attends/participates in classroom, on-line, and field exercise training events as applicable to assigned projects.

One year of full-time experience in the field of environmental activities may be substituted for each year (30 semester hours) of the required education.

Special Requirements:

Condition of Employment:
