### **Job Description:**

Provides highly advanced and complex consultative and technical assistance and managerial support related to state and federal air permit reviews and related support activities for the Air Permit Division of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Reviews complex state and/or federal (operating and new source) air permit applications, registrations, and certifications (i.e., permit projects) as necessary to assist with resolution of technical issues and/or with backlog reduction. Reviews shall define all sources of contaminants and appropriate federal and state requirements and may include rule interpretations, emission calculations, determination of federal applicability, permit shield issues, sufficiency of monitoring, and/or stringency determinations. Develop, review, and/or act as lead final reviewer for Requirements Reference Table (RRT) projects and/or IMS Logic Table projects for State and Federal regulations. Acts as a mentor for other permit reviewers and/or engineering technicians on various projects such as regulation citation evaluations and permit shield validity issues; acts as project manager as assigned; leads ongoing refresher technical training to staff as directed. Leads, conducts and/or participates in highly advanced projects/streamlining initiatives involving implementation of the Title V and New Source Review (NSR) Permitting programs; provides support for responses to Title V comment and objection letters and resolution of Title V/NSR programmatic issues (including Incorporation By Reference, appropriateness of various permitting mechanisms, sufficient monitoring, CAM and PM in either Title V or NSR permits, etc.). Serves as advisor and consultant to management and staff in technical matters and program functions; participates on agency and national teams and workgroups as directed; briefs commissioners, executive management, legislators, and public and industry groups. Communicates with applicants, agency staff, other state/federal agencies, elected officials, stakeholders, and the general public concerning inquiries pertaining to the applicability of federal and state requirements for the permitting process and the technical completeness of projects. Represents the division and agency at meetings, training sessions, and presentations. Attends formal and informal public meetings and mediations, responds to public comments as required, and participates as an expert witness in contested-case public hearings or meetings regarding permit applications and permit-by-rule registrations. Maintains and updates the Statement of Basis technical document, ensuring compliance with regulatory requirements and current TCEQ Air Permits Division Policy. Prepares policy and guidance materials, including the development and maintenance of technical guidance documents and policy memos. Participates in rule development, coordination of streamlining activities, development of federal policy/guidance documents, and facilitation of meetings.

Texas Professional Engineer's license plus five years of full-time engineering experience beyond licensure.  
Qualifying work experience includes that obtained post licensure as an engineering graduate student or teacher.  
OR One year of full-time experience as an Engineer V at TCEQ

**Preferred Requirements:**

Experience with air permitting programs, such as New Source Review and Title V.  
Experience training/mentoring/coaching peers or subordinates.  
Experience providing air regulatory training or presenting air regulatory information to groups.  
Experience contributing to and participating on APD or agency teams.  
Experience with processing, preparing, and reviewing of air permit applications.

**Special Requirements:**

Moving up to 20 pounds of equipment, documents and files.  
Traveling up to 5% of the time.

**Condition of Employment:**

TCEQ will verify Selective Service registration for males born on or after January 1, 1960.
