Job Description:

Conducts complex engineering reviews, evaluates and writes highly complex state and Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) permits, and completes other permit related activities for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Prepares TCEQ and/or TPDES draft individual/general permits and/or authorizations in accordance with state and federal rules, policies, and guidelines. Performs expert engineering related reviews and provides training and technical assistance for less experienced staff. Participates in complex special projects, including plans and specifications reviews; preparing correspondence; preparing authorization to construct requests; reviewing permit cancellation requests; attending pre-application and other meetings; and other assignments as requested. Provides engineering expertise concerning permits and the permitting process to agency staff, the general public, and the regulated community, attending meetings and responding to telephone calls and letters received by the program. Responds to comments on draft permits, prepares responses to comments documents, and revises permits and other documents as needed. Provides engineering expertise in the resolution of contested permit applications, assisting senior staff or the team leader in alternative dispute resolutions (ADRs), attending public meetings, and providing expert testimony at public hearings before an Administrative Law Judge or the Commission. Participates in training and continuing education related to water quality permitting and other technical/interpersonal skills related topics.

Minimum Qualifications:

Texas Professional Engineer's license plus four years of full-time engineering experience beyond licensure. Qualifying work experience includes that obtained post licensure as an engineering graduate student or teacher.
OR One year of full-time experience as an Engineer IV at TCEQ.

Special Requirements:

Moving up to 30 pounds of equipment/files.
Traveling up to 5% of the time.

The agency will review the applicant's driving history in connection with the use of a vehicle in the performance of the job.

Condition of Employment:

TCEQ will verify Selective Service registration for males born on or after January 1, 1960. Offers of employment are contingent on the candidate having legal authorization to work for the TCEQ. TCEQ will conduct a criminal history records search on candidates selected for posted vacancies.
