Job Description:

Maintains, operates, repairs, and audits air monitoring equipment and associated instrumentation to include conducting surveys and collecting and correlating air monitoring data. Operates and troubleshoots continuous and non-continuous air monitoring instrumentation in accordance with quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC) procedures. Conducts and documents onsite observations of local conditions influencing air quality data. Performs QA/QC analysis of continuous and non-continuous data to ensure quality instrument function and performance. Conducts laboratory control checks/audits on continuous air monitoring instrumentation. Assists with the coordination and/or oversight of contractors regarding the construction of new Air Monitoring sites; provides training and mentors junior level staff. Assists Systems Planning and Implementation Team in deployment of air monitoring instrumentation and facilities. Conducts non continuous instrument audits, calibrations, troubleshooting, diagnosis, and/or repairs, and assists with data validation of the PM2.5. Enhances job skills, and maintains current knowledge by attending training and seminars.

Minimum Qualifications:

Graduation from high school or GED certificate plus four years of full-time experience directly related to the examples of work performed.

One year (30 semester hours) of accredited college work (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION) which included six semester hours in mathematics or natural or physical science may be substituted for each year of required experience.

OR Graduation from a licensed vocational, technical, or business school with a certificate of completion in the areas directly related to the examples of work performed plus two years of full-time experience directly related to the examples of work performed.

OR A certificate of completion in areas directly related to the examples of work performed from a military technical training program plus three years of full-time experience directly related to the examples of work performed.

Preferred Requirements:

Experience operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting electronic equipment and instrumentation.

Experience operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting continuous and non-continuous air monitoring instrumentation.

Experience with Microsoft Office software, such as Microsoft Outlook, Word, or Excel.

Experience reviewing air monitoring data, or highly technical information, for quality, accuracy, and/or applicability.

Special Requirements:

Moving up to 50 pounds of equipment.

Traveling up to 50% of the time.

Using Air monitoring equipment, including calibration and audit equipment.

Using Test equipment such as Volt/Ohm meter, dial-a-volt, etc.

Working overtime as needed to complete assignments; travel overnight as necessary.

Condition of Employment:
