Job Description:

Performs technical work in the field of Water for the Houston Regional Office of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Utilizes geographic information systems (GIS) to locate, identify, and track Aggregate Production Operations (APOs) and other regulated activities of interest to the TCEQ; prepares basic maps and supporting documentation for investigations. Reviews GIS to conduct routine inspections, field surveys, and follow-up investigations; makes compliance determinations; prepares reports which document field activities and observed conditions. Conducts environmental monitoring; collects and/or compiles environmental data; researches regulatory compliance information and other environmental subjects in support of program objectives. Provides technical assistance to the public, regulated community and other interested groups regarding the application of appropriate regulations. Assists with collecting and analyzing environmental samples.

Minimum Qualifications:

A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, with a major in a natural or physical science, engineering, environmental studies, or related field (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION).

One year of full-time experience in the field of environmental activities directly related to the examples of work performed may be substituted for each year (30 semester hours) of the required education.

Preferred Requirements:

Experience interpreting environmental regulations and/or environmental permits.
Experience conducting inspections and/or investigations.

Experience using Geographical Information Systems (GIS) and interpreting mapping information.

Special Requirements:

Moving up to 35 pounds of equipment/samples.

Traveling up to 25% of the time.

Using sampling equipment to conduct inspections; using air purifying respirator when necessary.

Climbing to heights of 40 feet without acrophobia; working more than 40 hours per week, as needed, to complete assignments, or to assist with emergency response efforts.

The agency will review the applicant's driving history in connection with the use of a vehicle in the performance of the job.

Condition of Employment:

TCEQ will verify Selective Service registration for males born on or after January 1, 1960. If exempt from Selective Service registration selected candidate must provide proof of exemption on first day of employment. Offers of employment are contingent on the candidate having legal authorization to work for the TCEQ. TCEQ will conduct a criminal history records search on candidates selected for posted vacancies. Only applicants who are interviewed will receive written non-selection notification.
