**Job Description:**

Performs technical work in the field of emergency response for the Dallas/Fort Worth Regional Office of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Responds to spill and emergency response incidents, conducts investigations, makes recommendations for restoration of affected environments, and conducts follow-up investigations. Prepares, completes, and reviews reports related to spill/emergency response work and remediation plans; makes recommendations regarding cleanup findings performed by third-parties. Provides routine technical assistance to the public, regulated community, responsible parties, agency staff, and other interested groups; assists in developing emergency response procedures; participates in response meetings and drills; and prepares technical papers for presentations. Operates, maintains, and calibrates various monitoring instruments; conducts sampling activities and evaluates analytical results for compliance with applicable regulations. Assists in the development of training procedures and with training environmental investigators. Assesses and screens emergency response incidents for potential Natural Resource Damage Assessment (NRDA) action.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, with a major in a natural or physical science, engineering, environmental studies, or related field (COPY OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION).

One year of full-time experience in the field of environmental activities directly related to the examples of work performed may be substituted for each year (30 semester hours) of the required education.

**Preferred Requirements:**

Experience coordinating responses to emergency incidents and natural disasters.

**Special Requirements:**

Moving up to 35 pounds of equipment/samples.

Traveling up to 50% of the time.

Using sampling equipment to conduct inspections; using air purifying respirator when necessary.

Climbing to heights of 40 feet without acrophobia; working more than 40 hours per week, as needed, to complete assignments, or to assist with emergency response efforts.

The agency will review the applicant's driving history in connection with the use of a vehicle in the performance of the job.

**Condition of Employment:**

TCEQ will verify Selective Service registration for males born on or after January 1, 1960. If exempt from Selective Service registration selected candidate must provide proof of exemption on first day of employment. Offers of employment are contingent on the candidate having legal authorization to work for the TCEQ. TCEQ will conduct a criminal history records search on candidates selected for posted vacancies. Only applicants who are interviewed will receive written non-selection notification.
