#### **Condition of Employment:**

TCEQ will verify Selective Service registration for males born on or after January 1, 1960. If exempt from Selective Service registration selected candidate must provide proof of exemption on first day of employment.

Offers of employment are contingent on the candidate having legal authorization to work for the TCEQ.

TCEQ will conduct a criminal history records search on candidates selected for posted vacancies.

#### **Job Description:**

Completes simple to complex technical work involving the analysis, development, programming, and implementation/modification of agency software applications. Receives requests for application modifications, evaluates the requests, plans and designs work needed to satisfy request. Follows team and agency design and development standards and procedures. Creates or updates application code and/or scripts to meet business needs. Tests code, and assists non-programmers (support staff, program area staff and beta testers) with testing applications. Assists with the development of user manuals and staff instructions, and documents program code as necessary. Assists customers/users/program areas with questions related to software applications. Trains new customers on the use of new applications or changes to existing applications. Develop and maintain Crystal Reports according to team and agency standards and procedures.
