## ***Information from City of Fort Worth – Michael Gange, City of Fort Worth Assistant Director Environmental Management***

The SBAC was updated on the changes that will soon take place in the City of Fort Worth Environmental Management Division. The changes are not expected to change the interaction between the City of Fort Worth and the regulated customers as we perceive them. Final changes with restructure will take place September 21, 2010.

Brian Christian updated SBAC members on the new Rural Ombudsman position within the SBEA Division of TCEQ. Brian Christian updated members on the currently ongoing TCEQ Sunset Review. Regulated Entities (RE) and SBAC members can attend public hearings for Sunset in Austin December 15 & 16, 2010. Brian Christian updated committee on General Air Quality. Under the 1997 Ozone Standard, DFW will be upgraded to “serious” status. June 15, 2013 is the new attainment date for the 1997 Ozone standard. August 2010 is the expected date for the new standard. 1. Developed sites (construction) will be required to have controls.
2. For Municipal Separate Storm System (MS4) –one single permit is to be developed for Phase I and Phase II cities.
3. New turbidity rules will be added to the construction general permit.

### ***Petroleum Storage Tank (PST) Operators Rule:***

License is to be required for owners and operators of Underground Storage Tanks.
