4. These MUD districts could adversely affect my property values, overstress current infrastructure, first responders, and schools, increase traffic and crime, further impact storm and water drainage, and untold other negative effects not as yet ascertainable.
5. Our home is less than 2 miles from the northern most border of the proposed districts.

Rather than take their proposals to the County, they have chosen to move directly to the State for approval. Approval at the County level should have been sought so local and community conversations could be held to discuss the proposals in order to ensure a right fit for the surrounding areas. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256. Local governments, such as the County, with authority under state law over issues contemplated by an application, may be considered affected persons under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256(b). The County has authority over various functions – including but not limited to transportation, emergency services, and health and safety – that may be affected by the creation of the district and that the application fails to take into account. The City of Waxahachie opposes the creation of the District.

The City is an "affected person" entitled to a contested case hearing on issues raised in this hearing request because the City has interests related to legal rights, duties, privileges, powers, or economic interests affected by the application that are not common to the general public and is an affected person under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256. The proposed municipal utility district will be located entirely within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City. Local governments, such as the City, with authority under state law over issues contemplated by an application, may be considered affected persons under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256(b). The City has authority to protect the public health and safety within its extraterritorial jurisdiction and to regulate development within its extraterritorial jurisdiction. TEX. LOC. GOV'T CODE §§ 42.001, 212.044. Various city functions and services – including water and sewer services, emergency services, and health and safety concerns – may be affected by the creation of the district and are not taken into account by the application.

The City also has sewer facilities near the proposed district. As a regional water and sewer service provider, City has an interest to ensure that new development in its extraterritorial jurisdiction regionalize with existing system to the greatest extent possible in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its cities. *See* Texas Water Code § 26.081(a). The City therefore has an interest in ensuring the creation and operation of the proposed municipal utility district is protective of the public health and safety within its extraterritorial jurisdiction. Thus, the City has authority under state law over the issues contemplated by this application, has interests not common to the general public, and is therefore an affected person. 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256(b).

For these reasons, the City requests that the Commission find that the City is an affected person and grant its request for a contested case hearing.
