- Item 1. CONSIDERATION OF ACTIONS NEEDED TO BE TAKEN PURSUANT TO TEXAS WATER CODE SECTION 12.081; AND TEX. LAWS 1987, CH. 629, TO ASSURE PROPER MANAGEMENT OF EDWARDS UNDERGROUND AQUIFER WATER RESOURCES DURING THE CURRENT HYDROGEOLOGIC AND CLIMATIC CONDITIONS. (Haley)

Current condition of the Edwards Aquifer presents an imminent threat to public health and the environment due to concerns about impacts on public water supply.

COMMISSIONER BIRDWELL REPORTED ON THE FIVE COUNTIES AGREED ADOPTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS' EMERGENCY PLAN WITH EXCEPTION TO RECOMMENDED CHANGE. ALSO THIS EDWARDS AQUIFER MATTER CAN BE AND WILL BE PRESENTED AGAIN BEFORE THE TWC COMMISSION IF NECESSARY W/ADDITIONS OF 1208 AND 2811 RULES.
