The plant site is north of Fellows Road, approximately 3600 feet west of the intersection of Fellows Road and Farm-to-Market Road 518 (Cullen Boulevard) in Harris County, Texas. The effluent is discharged into Harris County Flood Control Ditch No. A-135-00-00; thence into Clear Creek in Segment No. 1102 of the San Jacinto-Brazos Coastal Basin.
