Item 1. Consideration of an application by SHELL OIL COMPANY for a Class 2 Modification to hazardous waste Permit No. HW50152 in accordance with 31 TAC Section 305.69. Shell operates a hazardous waste facility that stores, processes and disposes of refinery wastes. The facility is located on South Grandview Street, three miles south of Odessa in Ector County, Texas.

Item 2. APPLICATION BY CITY OF LAREDO for a permit (Proposed Permit No. 10681-06) to authorize a discharge of treated domestic wastewater effluent at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 35,000 gallons per day. The proposed wastewater treatment facility will serve a light industrial/commercial service area. The plant site is approximately 10.5 miles west-northwest of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Roads 1472 and 3338 and 1 mile southwest of Farm-to-Market 1472 on an unnamed county road, adjacent to the Rio Grande in Webb County, Texas.

Item 3. APPLICATION BY LYSSY DAIRY, INC. for a permit (Proposed Permit No. 03394) to authorize disposal of wastes and wastewater from a dairy which will consist of a maximum of 400 head. The dairy is on the west side of County Road 208, approximately three miles west of the intersection of County Road 204 and U.S. Highway 181 in Wilson County, Texas.

Item 4. APPLICATION BY CITY OF LA COSTE for an amendment to Permit No. 10889-01 in order to change from a permit authorizing disposal by evaporation and by irrigation to a discharge permit. The proposed amendment would also authorize an increase in the volume of treated domestic wastewater. The permit currently authorizes disposal of treated domestic wastewater effluent at a volume not to exceed 40,000 gallons per day average, which will remain as the interim phase. Upon completion of the facilities expansion, the proposed amendment would authorize a discharge at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 200,000 gallons per day. The wastewater treatment facilities are at the easterly city limits of the City of La Coste, approximately 0.5 mile east-southeast of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Highway 471 and Farm-to-Market Highway 2790, and 0.3 mile due south of the Southern Pacific Railroad in Medina County, Texas.

Item 5. APPLICATION BY TAPIA DAIRY, INC. for an amendment to Permit No. 02966 to authorize an increase in the maximum number of cows at the dairy from 500 head to 950 head. The dairy is

located approximately 4 miles northwest of the City of Miles, approximately 2 and 1/4 miles northwest of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Roads 2333 and 1692 in Runnels and Tom Green Counties, Texas.
