Item 1. APPLICATION BY A. L. MURPHY VETERANS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL for a municipal solid waste permit (Proposed Permit No. 2187) to authorize a Type V municipal solid waste site. The site will consist of approximately 0.20 acre of land and will receive approximately 5 tons of solid waste daily. The applicant will operate a medical waste incinerator. The site is to be approximately 2.0 miles northwest of the IH 10 and IH 410 interchange, at 7400 Merton Mintor Boulevard in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

Safety-Kleen operates a commercial hazardous waste recycling facility that stores and processes spent mineral spirits, spent carburetor cleaner, dry cleaner waste, spent immersion cleaner, and spent antifreeze for recycling at another location. The facility is located on Idalou Road (U.S. 62) 1.1 miles northeast of Loop 289 in the City of Lubbock, Lubbock County, Texas.

Them 7. APPLICATION BY U.S. NAVY/U.S. NAVAL WEAPONS INDUSTRIAL RESERVE PLANT for an amendment to Permit HW50081 which currently authorizes operation of (1) three container storage areas with a total capacity of 16,500 gallons and (2) continued interim status operation of a thermal processing area with a capacity of 2,000 pounds per unit. The proposed amendment would establish operating and closure standards for three separate open burn/open detonation units which are presently being operated under interim status standards. The facility is located on 9700 acres of land contiguous to the west side of State Highway 317, approximately 1/2 mile south of the City of McGregor in the counties of McLennan and Coryell.

Item 8. APPLICATION BY BAKER PERFORMANCE CHEMICAL CORPORATION for a permit (Proposed Permit No. 13580-01) to authorize a discharge of treated domestic wastewater effluent at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 1,000 gallons per day. The wastewater treatment facility is to be on the south side of Wallisville Road, approximately 300 feet east of the intersection of Sheldon Road and Wallisville Road in Harris County, Texas.

The plant site is at 6522 Interstate Highway 10 West which is approximately one (1) mile east of State Highway 62 and west of the City of Orange in Orange County, Texas.

The plant site is at 6055 South Mason Road, approximately 3 miles west and 3/4 mile north of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road

1093 and Farm-to-Market Road 1464 in Fort Bend County, Texas.
