- Item 1. Consideration of an application by CHEMICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT, INC. - Port Arthur Facility for Class 3 Modifications to Permit No. HW-50212-001 in accordance with 31 TAC Section 305.69. Chemical Waste operates a commercial hazardous and industrial solid waste management facility which accepts Class I hazardous and Class I and Class II waste received from off-site generators and generated on-site for storage and processing. The facility is on a 17.022-acre tract of land on the south side of State Highway 73, approximately 3.2 miles west of the intersection of State Highway 73 and Taylor Bayou in Port Arthur, Jefferson County, Texas.

- Item 3. APPLICATION BY C & W MANHATTAN ASSOCIATES dba Manhattan Farms for a permit (Proposed Permit No. 03527) to authorize disposal of waste and wastewater from a dairy operation. The dairy will consist of a maximum of 600 head. Wash-down water, flushwater and stormwater will be retained in 2 storage ponds, where subsequently it will be used to irrigate agricultural land. Manure/solids will be disposed of as fertilizer on agricultural land. The dairy is on the west side of Farm-to-Market Road 3176 approximately two miles north of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 3176 and Farm-to-Market Road 462 in Frio County, Texas.

- Item 4. APPLICATION BY CITY OF RICHMOND for a permit (Proposed Permit No. 10258-03) to authorize a discharge of treated domestic wastewater effluent at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 3,000,000 gallons per day from the Golfview Regional Wastewater Treatment Facilities. The plant site is at 304 Golfview Drive on the east side of Rabbs Bayou, approximately 300 feet north of Golfview Drive in Fort Bend County, Texas.

UNCONTESTED (WATER QUALITY PERMIT AMENDMENTS)

Item 5. APPLICATION BY CONOCO, INC., Wichita Falls Petroleum Storage Facility for an amendment to Permit No. 02918 to authorize an additional five outfalls (Outfalls 002 - 006) to regulate intermittent, flow variable discharges of stormwater. The permit currently authorizes intermittent, flow variable discharges of stormwater via Outfall 001. The applicant operates a petroleum products storage terminal. The plant site is at 1214 North Eastside Drive in the City of Wichita Falls, Wichita County, Texas.

Item 6. APPLICATION BY CITY OF PARIS for an amendment to Permit No. 10479-01 in order to change disposal methods of sludge, currently being hauled to a disposal site, to spray irrigation on a 205 acre diked area adjacent to the City of Paris water treatment plant. The proposed amendment also authorizes discharge of water treatment sludge decant no more than 3 times per month at a maximum of 1,200,000 gallons per discharge event. The permit currently authorizes to discharge water treatment sludge decant at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 1,200,000 gallons per day. The plant site is on Lake Crook Road, approximately 1 mile west of U.S. Highway 271, directly east of Lake Crook dam and north of the City of Paris in Lamar County, Texas.

Item 7. APPLICATION BY CITY OF PASADENA for an amendment to Permit No. 10053-03 to authorize an increase in the discharge of treated domestic wastewater effluent from a volume not to exceed 5,000,000 gallons per day average to a volume not to exceed 10,000,000 gallons per day average. The proposed amendment would divert the flow from the Golden Acre East Plant, Permit No. 10053-07, to the Golden Acre Plant, Permit No. 10053-03. Upon completion of the diversion, Permit No. 10053-07 would be canceled. The plant site is on the north bank of Armand (Middle) Bayou in the 6300 block of Spencer Road in southeast Pasadena, Harris County, Texas.

Item 8. APPLICATION BY R. W. MCDONNELL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. for an amendment to Permit No. 13587-01 to change the method of disposal from evaporation and irrigation to irrigation only. The proposed amendment would also increase the irrigation site from 2 acres to 7.55 acres of land. The disposal volume is not to exceed an average of 12,600 gallons per day. Application rates for the irrigated land are not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet/acre/year. The wastewater treatment facility, effluent storage pond and irrigation site are located approximately 0.8 mile east of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 753 and State Highway 31 in Henderson County, Texas.

Item 9. APPLICATION BY JAMES P.S. GRIFFITH dba Tejas Properties for renewal of Permit No. 11160-01 which authorizes a discharge of treated domestic wastewater effluent at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 70,000 gallons per day from the Tejas Properties Wastewater Treatment Plant. The plant site is in the northern portion of the City of Houston, approximately 16.7 miles north-northeast of the City of Houston central business district, at a point 1.9 miles west of U.S. Highway 59, and approximately 1,000 feet north of Jetero Boulevard just east of Lee Road in Harris County, Texas.

Item 10. APPLICATION BY CITY OF HARKER HEIGHTS for renewal of Permit No. 10155-01 which authorizes a discharge of treated domestic wastewater effluent at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 3,000,000 gallons per day. The wastewater treatment facilities are approximately 3,000 feet northwest of the intersection of U.S. Highway 190 and Farm-to-Market Road 3219, approximately 1/4 mile north of U.S. Highway 190 on the south bank of Nolan Creek in Bell County, Texas.

The wastewater treatment plant is approximately 2000 feet south of Spring Cypress Road and 5000 feet east of the intersection of Louetta Road and Spring Cypress Road in Harris County, Texas.

Item 12.
