**NOTICE OF HEARING
JARRAR HOLDINGS LLC
SOAH Docket No. 582-16-3298

APPLICATION.

Jarrar Holdings LLC, 9119 Emmot Road, Houston, Texas 77040, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0015299001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 12,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on September 11, 2014.

The facility will be located at 16825 Hollister Street, in Harris County, Texas 77066. The treated effluent will be discharged to Harris County Flood Control District (HCFCD) ditch 149-00-00; thence to Greens Bayou Above Tidal in Segment No. 1016 of the San Jacinto River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is minimal aquatic life use for HCFCD ditch 149-00-00. The designated uses for Segment No. 1016 are limited aquatic life use and primary contact recreation.

In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 307.5 and the TCEQ implementation procedures (June 2010) for the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards, an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review is not required since no exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life use water bodies have been identified in the discharge route. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received.

The TCEQ Executive Director has prepared a draft permit which, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at the Harris County Public Library, Katherine Tyra Branch at Bear Creek, 16719 Clay Road, Houston, Texas. CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a formal contested case hearing at:

The contested case hearing will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on March 4, 2016. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing. Unless agreed to by all parties in attendance at the preliminary hearing, an evidentiary hearing will not be held on the date of this preliminary hearing.
